ACT 566 (HB 746)

Prior law required oversized vehicles or combination of vehicles that did not meet the requirements of existing law obtain a special permit issued by the Dept. of Transportation and Development, in addition to any other required permits by other agencies, departments, or political subdivisions, when using public highways of the state.

New law modifies prior law by prohibiting any special permit outside of the permits required by the DOTD.

New law provides that new law does not apply to the parishes of Bossier and Caddo.

New law establishes a one-year moratorium on the issuance of local permits for oversized vehicles and prohibits political subdivisions from adopting new permit requirements during the established moratorium.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 29, 2026).
