ACT 704 (HB 1108)

New law requires that the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C), office of motor vehicles (OMV), issue a special prestige license plate to be known as the "Homeschool Proud" license plate, provided that there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants for such plates.

New law specifies that the plate is restricted to use on passenger cars, pick up trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans. Further directs the DPS&C, OMV, to create this special prestige license plate when the applicable statutory provisions are met and the dept.'s electronic vehicle and registration system is updated to accommodate the creation of the new plates.

New law requires that the secretary work in conjunction with the artist selected by Homeschool La. to design the plate. Requires that the bottom of the plate bear the words "Homeschool Proud". Requires a symbol representing Homeschool La. appear on the left portion of the plate. Requires the center portion of the plate have five alpha-numeric digits for registration purposes.

New law specifies that the license plate will be issued, upon application, to any citizen of the state in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

New law requires that the dept. collect an annual fee of \$25 in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed in existing law and a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate to be retained by the dept. to offset a portion of administrative costs.

New law requires the annual royalty fee collected by the dept. be forwarded to Homeschool La. and all monies be used solely for the activities of Homeschool La.

New law requires the secretary promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of new law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
