LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Declares May 4, 2016, as Child Care Provider Appreciation Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To declare May 4, 2016, as "Child Care Provider Appreciation Day" at the Louisiana State
3	Capitol.
4	WHEREAS, the second Sunday in May has long been recognized as the day to honor
5	mothers and their commitment to children; and
6	WHEREAS, the Friday before Mother's Day, May 6, 2016, is Child Care Provider
7	Appreciation Day, a special day to recognize child care providers, teachers, school-age
8	program staff, child care center directors and staff, and all those who work with children and
9	are responsible for their education and care; and
10	WHEREAS, it is estimated that nearly eleven million children under age five are
11	cared for by two million eight hundred thousand child care providers in the United States;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, Child Care Provider Appreciation Day began in 1996 by a group of
14	volunteers in New Jersey who saw the need to recognize the tireless efforts of providers who
15	care for children of working parents; and
16	WHEREAS, momentum and support for this event has grown each year and
17	recognition presently includes individuals and government organizations throughout North
18	America, Europe, and Asia; and

l	WHEREAS, of the twenty million children under age five in America, nearly eleven
2	million are in some form of child care settings; and
3	WHEREAS, the Child Care Association of Louisiana, a statewide, nonprofit
4	organization represents the interests of licensed child care providers and children they serve,
5	and wholeheartedly endorses and promotes the Child Care Provider Appreciation Day; and
6	WHEREAS, the mission of the Child Care Association of Louisiana is to educate,
7	advocate, and collaborate to build a premier, proactive child care industry for Louisiana
8	families; and
9	WHEREAS, by calling attention to the importance of high quality child care services
10	for all children and families within the state, the Child Care Association of Louisiana and
11	other advocacy organizations hope to improve the quality and availability of such services;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, our future depends on the quality of the early childhood experiences
14	provided to young children today and high quality early child care services represent a
15	worthy commitment to our children's future; and
16	WHEREAS, "Every child should have access to a high quality early childhood
17	educational program and be prepared to enter kindergarten ready to learn," says Jonathon
18	Pearce, president of the Child Care Association of Louisiana.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
20	does hereby declare May 4, 2016, as "Child Care Provider Appreciation Day" at the
21	Louisiana State Capitol and urge all citizens to recognize licensed childcare providers for
22	their important work.
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
24	president and the executive director of the Child Care Association of Louisiana.
