

1 "Simulation of Groundwater Flow in the '1,500-foot' Sand and the '2,000-foot' Sand and
2 Movement of Saltwater in the '2,000-foot' Sand of the Baton Rouge Area, Louisiana" report;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, according to the abstract of that report, "Groundwater withdrawals have
5 caused saltwater to encroach into freshwater-bearing aquifers beneath Baton Rouge,
6 Louisiana. Groundwater investigations in the 1960s identified a freshwater-saltwater
7 interface located at the Baton Rouge Fault, across which abrupt changes in water levels
8 occur."

9 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
10 urge and request the commissioner of conservation to study the effects of the ground water
11 withdrawals on the sustainability of the Southern Hills Aquifer System and on the water
12 supplies and water levels, including the lowering of the water table, of parishes currently
13 relying on that ground water and to report those findings to the House Committee on Natural
14 Resources and Environment and the Senate Committee on Environmental Quality on or
15 before March 1, 2017.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
17 to the commissioner of conservation.
