<u>Prior law</u> provided that the fine which may be imposed for violation of any parking regulation established by the governing authority of any state-supported college or university, including Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, where the violation occurred upon the streets and roadways of such college or university, shall not exceed \$1.

<u>Prior law</u> was held unconstitutional in *Student Government Association of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, Main Campus, Baton Rouge v. Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, 264 So.2d 916 (La. 1972).*

New law repeals prior law.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 5, 2016).
