COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Louisiana State University women's gymnastics team on an outstanding 2016 season

A RESOLUTION

2	To commend the Louisiana State University women's gymnastics team on an outstanding
3	2016 season.
4	WHEREAS, the Louisiana State University (LSU) gymnastics team completed its
5	season as the national runner-up at the 2016 Women's National Collegiate Gymnastics
6	Championship in Fort Worth, Texas; and
7	WHEREAS, the Lady Tigers tallied a score of 197.45 to place second, the best finish
8	in school history; and
9	WHEREAS, the Lady Tigers used a solid 197.33 score in the Semifinal I to earn a
10	spot in the Super Six to qualify for the national championship meet, the third time in the last
11	four years and the fifth time overall; and
12	WHEREAS, for the first time in school history, LSU's women's gymnastics team
13	reached the 30-win milestone with a 31-6 overall record; and
14	WHEREAS, the Lady Tigers' postseason record was 18-4, and the eighteen
15	postseason wins are the most in a single season in LSU history; and
16	WHEREAS, LSU ranked in the top five in all four events, one of only three teams
17	in the nation to do so; and
18	WHEREAS, for the third consecutive season, the LSU women's gymnastics team
19	finished with a perfect home record and compiled seventeen total All-America honors:
20	eleven at the championships and six in the regular season; and

1	WHEREAS, LSU shattered the home attendance record for the fourth straight
2	season; an average nine thousand nine hundred six fans attended each meet this season, and
3	a school record of thirteen thousand two hundred ninety-six fans packed the Pete Maravich
4	Assembly Center on March 4, 2016, to watch LSU defeat Alabama 197.925 to 196.225; and
5	WHEREAS, head coach D-D Breaux reached an exclusive milestone of seven
6	hundred career wins at the national championships; and
7	WHEREAS, Ashleigh Gnat earned Southeastern Conference (SEC) Specialist of the
8	Year and National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches / Women Central Region
9	Gymnast of the Year honors; and
10	WHEREAS, Ms. Gnat also won the SEC floor exercise title, the fifth gymnast in
11	LSU history to claim the honor; and
12	WHEREAS, Sydney Ewing, Sara Finnegan, Ashleigh Gnat, Myia Hambrick, Lexie
13	Priessman, and Jessica Savona earned a combined seventeen All-America honors during the
14	2016 season; and
15	WHEREAS, Ms. Finnegan and McKenna Kelley both earned SEC All-Freshman
16	honors to become the seventh and eighth LSU gymnasts to earn the distinction since the
17	honor began in 2009, and Ms. Finnegan, Ms. Gnat, and Ms. Hambrick tallied All-SEC
18	honors, giving LSU a grand total of seventy in program history; and
19	WHEREAS, Ms. Hambrick was the national runner-up for the floor exercise national
20	title and placed third in the final all-around standings, and Ms. Gnat set the LSU
21	single-season record with six perfect 10 scores, including a school single-season record of
22	four perfect scores on floor exercise and two perfect scores on vault; and
23	WHEREAS, LSU won a total of nine SEC Weekly honors: Ms. Hambrick was SEC
24	Gymnast of the Week three times, Ms. Gnat was SEC Gymnast of the Week once, Ms. Shae
25	Zamardi was SEC Specialist of the Week once, Ms. Gnat was SEC Specialist of the Week
26	once, and Ms. Sarah Finnegan was SEC Freshman of the Week three times; and
27	WHEREAS, six Lady Tigers finished the season ranked in the top twenty-five
28	nationally in at least one category, a feat which tied a school record; and

1 WHEREAS, twenty routines and six All-Americans are expected to return for the 2 2017 season, as well as three talented newcomers, Kennedi Edney, Ruby Harrold, and 3 Ashlyn Kirby, who will join the team; and 4 WHEREAS, the amazing accomplishments of the team could not have been achieved 5 without the guidance and skills of head coach D-D Breaux, associate head coach Jay Clark, 6 assistant coach Bob Moore, volunteer coach Ashleigh-Clare Kearney, and director of 7 operations Katie Copeland, along with all the other individuals who have contributed to the 8 success of the LSU women's gymnastics program; and 9 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of 10 Louisiana wish to recognize each of the coaches and the extraordinary Lady Tigers team 11 members on their much deserved success throughout the 2016 season, which was earned 12 through hard work, determination, and dedication to the great sport of gymnastics. 13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 14 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend and congratulate the players and coaches of 15 the Louisiana State University Tigers women's gymnastics team on an outstanding and 16 memorable season and on becoming the national runner-up at the 2016 Women's National 17 Collegiate Gymnastics Championship. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to head 19 coach D-D Breaux.
