Urges and requests the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority to study and make recommendations relative to multijurisdictional cost-share funding of flood protection projects.

Requires the study include the benefits of multijurisdictional funding for flood protection projects for the state of Louisiana and its citizens.

Requires the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority to submit a written report to the Senate and House committees on transportation, highways and public works, the Senate Committee on Natural Resources, the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment, and the member of the House of Representatives representing House District No. 52 on or before Dec. 31, 2016.

Specifies that the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority work with staff of the Senate and House committees on transportation, highways and public works to develop legislation that proposes multijurisdictional funding of flood protection projects, if the results of the study illustrate such funding would be beneficial.
