

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**

CHILDREN/SUPPORT: Provides for the schedule of basic child support obligations

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Changes the lowest monthly income in the child support obligations schedule from \$0-\$950 to \$0-\$900.
2. Changes the calculated guideline for monthly support for several of the combined adjusted monthly gross income categories in the schedule of basic child support obligations.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law provides a child support guideline schedule which is based on economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

Proposed law amends present law to incorporate the most recent economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

Present law provides monthly basic child support obligations for combined adjusted monthly gross incomes beginning with \$0 per month.

Proposed law amends the monthly basic child support obligations and utilizes \$0-\$900 as the minimum adjusted monthly gross income.

Present law provides a ceiling of \$30,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Proposed law amends present law by raising the ceiling from \$30,000 to \$40,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.
