8	WHEREAS, public works improvements such as roadways, railways, drainage
9	systems, sewage and water treatment systems, airports, harbor areas, and ports are all
0	necessary to make modern societies work efficiently and effectively; and
1	WHEREAS, public works improvements affect the everyday lives of citizens
12	residing in local communities throughout the state of Louisiana, and citizens depend on local
13	governmental subdivisions to provide many of these improvements within their respective
4	communities; and
15	WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1128 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature
16	proposes to enact R.S. 39:2211 to establish time frames within which all obligations arising
17	under public contracts are to be paid and remedies for those who fail to receive timely
18	payments; and
9	WHEREAS, testimony was given during a committee hearing on House Bill No.
20	1128 regarding issues that arise when local governmental subdivisions fail to make timely

payments on public works contracts, including financial stress endured by those who are parties to such contracts and the exposure of the public to potential safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, local governmental subdivisions must provide public work improvements of the highest quality, and it is imperative that they make timely payments to contractors who provide such improvements in order to ensure that quality standards are maintained, which will ultimately ensure the health and safety of their residents.

THEREFORE, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana requests the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to study and make recommendations regarding procedures that can be implemented in order to address the failure of local governmental subdivisions to make timely payments on public works contracts and to report its findings to the House of Representatives no later that thirty days prior to the convening of the 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
