Abstract: Authorizes the House and Governmental Affairs Committee to receive criminal history record information from the La. Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information.

Present law (R.S. 15:577 and 578) creates, within Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, the La. Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information which has the responsibility for establishing and maintaining a central repository of criminal history records. Proposed law retains present law.

Present law requires the bureau to provide such information, upon request and as the deputy secretary of DPS&C designates, to any eligible criminal justice agency, and the La. Dept. of Health, the state fire marshal, DCFS, the Dept. of Insurance, the La. State Racing Commission, the Senate and Governmental Affairs Committee, the executive director of the La. Workforce Commission or his designee, the Board of River Port Pilot Commissioners, the Office of Financial Institutions in the office of the governor, the office of the disciplinary counsel of the La. Attorney Disciplinary Board, the La. Supreme Court Committee on Bar Admissions, the municipal or parish department or personnel responsible for reviewing applications for alcoholic beverage outlet permits, and the legislative auditor.

Proposed law retains present law and adds the House and Governmental Affairs Committee as an entity eligible to receive such information from the bureau.
