Abstract: Prohibits the roadside sale of domestic rabbits in the state.

Proposed law prohibits a person from selling, offering for sale, delivering, bartering, auctioning, giving away, or transferring any rabbit on the shoulder of the road of any state, local, or interstate highway or at any festival in this state.

Proposed law provides health, food, and water maintenance requirements for stores, shops, vendors, and others offering domestic rabbits for sale.

Proposed law establishes a fine of not more than \$100, or imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both. Specifies that each occurrence of a violation constitutes a separate offense.
