AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 32:1254(O), relative to distribution and sale of motor vehicles; to provide for
3	a licensing exception for speciality vehicle dealers who manufacture wheeled
4	armored personnel carriers for sale to law enforcement agencies; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 32:1254(O) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1254. Application for license; requirements for licensure; contents; licenses
9	franchise filings; exceptions
10	* * *
11	O. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Chapter and the provisions of
12	Subsection N of this Section to the contrary, this Chapter shall not apply to
13	specialty vehicle dealers who manufacture wheeled, armored personnel carriers
14	for sale to law enforcement agencies and who do not maintain or have a place
15	of business in this state.
16	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if no
17	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

- by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 2 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 3 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> requires certain persons, including specialty vehicle dealers, to first obtain a license from the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission before engaging in business in this state, regardless of whether or not said person maintains or has a place or places of business in this state.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides an exception to the provisions of <u>present law</u> and the rules and regulations of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission for specialty vehicle dealers who manufacture wheeled, armored personnel carriers for sale to law enforcement agencies and who do not maintain or have a place of business in this state.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
