TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE: Provides relative to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 26:352, relative to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law; to 3 provide relative to donations of beverages of high and low alcoholic content; to 4 provide for the applicability of excise taxes on donated alcoholic beverages to certain 5 events or organizations; and to provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 26:352 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §352. Donated alcoholic beverages of high and low alcoholic content taxable 9 Any person or any dealer may donate alcoholic beverages of high and low 10 alcoholic content to a licensed Type A special event or to an unlicensed civic, 11 religious, or charitable organization subject to the payment of any applicable excise 12 taxes. 13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 14 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 15 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 16 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 17 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Specifies that beverages of high and low alcoholic content may be donated to certain organizations and events.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the donation of alcoholic beverages to licensed Type A special events or unlicensed civic, religious, or charitable organizations, subject to applicable excise taxes.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to clarify that <u>present law</u> applies to beverages of high and low alcoholic content.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
