Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of I-49 North from I-220 to La. Highway 1 as the T.J. Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA Expressway

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 48:1844, relative to interstate highways; to designate a certain portion of
3 Interstate 49 in Shreveport as the T.J. Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA
4 Expressway; to provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 48:1844 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §1844. T.J. Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA Expressway

8 That portion of Interstate 49 from its intersection with Interstate 220 in
9 Shreveport to its intersection with Louisiana Highway 1 in Shreveport as the T.J.
10 Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA Expressway.

11 Section 2. This Act shall only take effect and become operative if and when the
12 portion of Interstate 49 from its intersection with Interstate 220 in Shreveport to its
13 intersection with Louisiana Highway 1 in Shreveport is completed by the Department of
14 Transportation and Development or its contractors.

Abstract: Designates a portion of Interstate 49 from its intersection with Interstate 220 in Shreveport to its intersection with Louisiana Highway 1 in Shreveport as the T.J. Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA Expressway.

Proposed law designates the portion of I-49 from its intersection with I-220 in Shreveport to its intersection with La. Hwy. 1 in Shreveport as the T.J. Hawkins, Craig E. Lear, Cooper Road USA Expressway.

Proposed law makes proposed law contingent upon the completion, by the Dept. of Transportation and Development, of the section of I-49 identified in proposed law.
