PURPOSE OF THE BILL: Provides for an increase in the amount per diem for members of the board of the Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry parish from a range of \$25-\$40 to a range of \$40-\$100 per meeting, not to exceed twelve meetings per year.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on local governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

According to an official with the Hospital Service District, board member per diem is currently \$40. If this measure passes, the board may move to increase their per diem. Also, the expenses for the district are paid by the Ville Platte Medical Center, LLA d/b/a Mercy Regional Medical Center in accordance with the "Lease and Management Agreement" between the two entities. Therefore, the per diem is not an expense to the district.

Currently, there are 6 board members that meet quarterly. The impact on per diem increasing to \$100 per meeting would be between \$1,440 and \$4,320 per year depending on the number of meetings that are held (up to the maximum of 12).

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on local governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
