Provides relative to fees imposed by the Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes or increases fees for certain license renewal, permits, registrations, inspections, and expired certificates as well as increases fines for certain violations, and provides that assessed fees are nonrefundable. <u>Proposed law</u> also removes the requirement for examinations for special permits to be given at least twice a year, and further provides that applicants are responsible for costs of exams administered by a third-party testing company at the board's testing center or at an off site testing center. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the reference to certain resident and non-resident statuses, positions, permits, and applicable fees.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will provide a net increase in revenues for the Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology due to changes in classifications and fee structures. Fee revenues totaled \$1,034,730 (39,055 licenses) in 2016. Under the proposed legislation the board would collect an estimated amount of \$1,071,880 in FY 18 and beyond, an increase of \$37,200 annually.

The fee for all initial applications as well as annual renewals under the categories of cosmetologist, esthetician, manicurist, and teacher will now pay a flat fee of \$25; decreasing revenues by \$21,125 (in 2016, 33,351 licenses were issued which generated \$854,900).

Managers, booth renters, special and temporary permit holders will now pay a fee of \$35 for an initial licenses and renewals; increasing revenues by \$1,230 (in 2016, 123 licenses were issued for a collection of \$3,075).

The initial license fee, the annual renewal fee, and change of ownership or location fee for beauty shops or salons will now have a flat fee of \$40; increasing revenues by \$54,625 (in 2016, there were 5,515 licenses which generated \$169,975). The fee for the initial inspection for a salon or booth rental which is now required for openings, change of ownership or change of location would increase to \$35 from the current fee of \$25 (there were no listed collections for 2016). The initial certificate of registration for a school would have a flat rate of \$400; increasing revenues by \$170 (in 2016, the board issued 2 which generated \$630).

The renewal fee for a school has a proposed flat rate of \$200; increasing revenues by \$2,100 (in 2016, the board issued 60 which generated \$9,900).

The proposed legislation would increase other school fees as follows: initial inspection or failure to timely renew from \$100 to \$150 (generated \$100 in 2016), final inspection from \$300 to \$350, and change of ownership notice from \$50 to \$100 (generated \$150 in 2016).

The proposed legislation also increases fine amounts from \$25 to \$35 and increases the maximum to \$350 (currently \$300) per week from any person, school or facility provided that the registrant waives his rights to a hearing in writing. The board collected \$1,900 (76 fines) in 2016.
