

1 WHEREAS, children with special needs such as Down syndrome, autism-spectrum
2 disorder, paraplegia, muscular dystrophy, human immunodeficiency virus, and cerebral
3 palsy are welcomed into Camp Tiger; and

4 WHEREAS, to date, more than four thousand Louisiana campers and eight thousand
5 LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans School of Medicine students have participated
6 in the program.

7 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
8 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Camp Tiger program at the LSU Health
9 Sciences Center New Orleans School of Medicine; does hereby commend the faculty, staff,
10 and students who support Camp Tiger for their contributions to the well-being and happiness
11 of Louisiana children with special needs; and does hereby commend the continuing existence
12 of this exemplary, free summer camp that is nonjudgmental and welcomes special needs
13 children.
