16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 1, delete lines 13 and 14 in their entirety and insert the following:

18 "B. The constable of a justice of the peace court shall be entitled to a fee of  
19 six percent for collecting money for execution of a writ of fieri facias, without either  
20 seizure or sale.

21 B C. Fifty percent of each fee and deposit collected pursuant to Subsection  
22 A of this Section shall be retained by the justice of the peace for fees and operational  
23 expenses of the office and court, and fifty percent of the fees and deposits shall be  
24 used for fees and operational expenses of the ward constable's office.

25 € D. Except when the plaintiff is relieved from the necessity of paying costs  
26 or furnishing security therefor, under ~~Articles 5181 through 5188 of the Code of~~  
27 Civil Procedure Articles 5181 through 5188 or ~~under~~ R.S. 13:4521, a justice of the  
28 peace may demand that the plaintiff provide costs in advance."
