Abstract: Requires risk-bearing entities to submit current contact information to the commissioner of insurance.

Proposed law requires each risk-bearing entity to annually inform the commissioner of the name, address, phone number, and electronic mail address of the contact person responsible for each of the following duties:

- (1) The receipt of and response to consumer complaints.
- (2) The receipt of rules, regulations, and directives from the commissioner.
- (3) The receipt and filing of inquiries into the financial state of the company.
- (4) The receipt and filing of tax payments.
- (5) Any other duty or function the commissioner deems necessary.

Proposed law requires that a risk-bearing entity notify the commissioner within 30 days of any change in any of the information required by proposed law.

Effective January 1, 2018.
