<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 15:146) creates the La. Public Defender Board of 11 members as a state agency within the office of the governor to provide for the supervision, administration, and delivery of a statewide public defender system. <u>Proposed law</u> retains present law.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> requires a quorum of eight voting members in order for the board to transact business.

<u>Proposed law</u> reduces the quorum necessary for the board $\underline{\text{from}}$ eight voting members $\underline{\text{to}}$ a majority of the voting members.
