Creates the Advisory Council on Heroin and Opioid Prevention and Education

Proposed law requires the Drug Policy Board to establish an Advisory Council on Heroin and Opioid Prevention and Education to coordinate resources and expertise to assist in a statewide response.

Proposed law requires the council to coordinate parish-level data on opioid overdoses and usage of overdose-reversal medication as current and accurate statewide data is critical in educating both those involved in policy development and the citizens of this state.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation is anticipated to result in an indeterminable, but minimal, increase in SGF expenditures associated with travel reimbursements.

This bill establishes the Drug Policy Board’s Advisory Council on Heroin and Opioid Prevention and Education. The council consists of 13 voting members and shall include a minimum 9 nonvoting ex officio members. The council members shall not receive compensation or a per diem for their services or attendance at council meetings. However, the proposed legislation requires travel-related expenses be reimbursed by the council member’s respective agency. The bill indicates that there shall be a minimum of 4 meetings per year. The current state milage reimbursement rate is \$0.59 per mile.
