AN ACT

To enact R. S. 17:1891 within Chapter 6 of Title 17 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, relative to granting of free tuition by Tulane University; to provide relative to the Tulane Legislative Scholarship; to require that a student's legislative scholarship be applied toward his financial obligations before certain other award amounts; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:1891 is hereby enacted within Chapter 6 of Title 17 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 to read as follows:

§1891. Tulane Legislative Scholarship; payment

For a student enrolled in Tulane University who is the recipient of both a Tulane Legislative Scholarship and an award pursuant to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students, the university shall apply the full amount of the Tulane Legislative Scholarship toward the student's financial obligations to the university before applying any award amounts provided through the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students.
