SENATE BILL NO. 200

SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Provides for an increase of members to the board of supervisors of the Livingston Parish Sewer District. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:3887(C), relative to the Livingston Parish Sewer District; to provide for an
3 increase in the membership of the board of supervisors; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 33:3887(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §3887. Supervising board

9 * * *

10 **C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A, the board of**
11 **supervisors of the Livingston Parish Sewer District shall consist of seven**
12 **members, subject to all other requirements of qualifications for office provided**
13 **in Subsection A.**

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

1 effective on the day following such approval.

SB 200 Engrossed 2017 Regular Session Erdey

Present law provides for the police jury to appoint at least three but no more than five property taxpayers residing within the district as the board of supervisors.

Proposed law retains present law and requires the governing authority of Livingston Parish to increase the number of board supervisors from five to seven for the Livingston Parish Sewer District.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
