 Establishes a temporary permit fee for food and beverage vendors at fairs and festivals

Proposed law authorizes LA Department of Health (LDH), Office of Public Health (OPH) to charge a temporary fee of \$37.50 to each food and beverage vendor at the New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival. Proposed law is effective upon the signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation increases Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$2,813 in FY 18 and in future fiscal years within the Office of Public Health (OPH). The proposed legislation authorizes new temporary permit fee of \$37.50 on food vendors at the New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival. Presently, OPH assesses only a \$25 to permit the whole New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival. Under this measure, each food and beverage vendor at the festival will be required to pay a temporary permit fee of \$37.50. The new fee is project to generate \$2,813 annually (\$37.50 x 75 vendors = \$2,812.50).
