Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Original Senate Bill No. 249 by Senator Chabert

## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 4, delete "to define certain terms;"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 1, line 12, after "(5)" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 13 through 17,
- 5 and delete pages 2 and 3
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 15, and insert the following:
- "(a) Beginning with Fiscal Year 2022, a portion of the total federal revenues received by the state generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity shall be dedicated solely for hurricane protection projects, including operation and maintenance, that are included in or consistent with the master plan as follows:

  (i) For Fiscal Years 2022 through 2024, a minimum of thirty-five percent.
- 15 (ii) For Fiscal Years 2025 through 2027, a minimum of forty percent.

  16 (iii) For Fiscal Years 2028 through 2030, a minimum of forty-five percent.
- 18 (iv) For Fiscal Year 2031 and subsequent fiscal years, a minimum of fifty percent.
- 20 (b) If the total federal revenues received by the state generated from
  21 Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity are less than one hundred million
  22 dollars in any fiscal year, then the minimum dedications contained in
  23 Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall not apply."
