Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 42 by Senator Johns

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 7, after "meetings;" and before "and to" insert "to provide for an effective
3 date;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 4, line 23, change "**State Public Defender**" to "**state public defender**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 6, line 5, after "**to as**" and before the comma "," delete "**the**" and change "**advisory**
8 **board**" to "**advisory board**"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 6, line 24, after "**Children**" and before "**and any**" insert a comma ","

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 8, after line 27, insert the following:

13 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
14 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
15 without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
16 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
17 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
