4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary shall review current laws regarding

6 current state law, and if not, to provide recommendations to the legislature for legislation no
7 later than December 31, 2017.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
9 to the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.

Directs the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to determine the feasibility of privatizing correctional facilities, excluding La. State Penitentiary and Elayn Hunt Correctional Center, determine potential cost savings, recommend programs for state offenders housed locally, and determine if state law permits privatization. Requires determinations to be submitted to the legislature by Dec. 31, 2017.
