**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to  
Original House Bill No. 93 by Representative MiguezAMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 11:1307(B)" and before "and" insert a comma "," and "2185,  
and 2235"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, at the end of line 3, change "state" to "law enforcement officer"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, delete "trooper"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." and before "hereby" change "R.S. 11:1307(B) is" to  
"R.S. 11:1307(B), 2185, and 2235 are"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, at the end of line 17, insert the following:

"The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply if the family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under the provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law. If more than one immediate family member seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest immediate family member who seeks to purchase the firearm shall be entitled to purchase the firearm on behalf of the qualifying member of the office of state police."

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 1, after line 18, add the following:

"§2185. Retirement; purchase of firearm

Any sheriff or deputy sheriff who retires with at least sixteen years of active service and who is in good standing with the Louisiana Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund shall be entitled to purchase his firearm at fair market value upon retirement, subject to approval by the sheriff. In accordance with the provisions of this Section, an immediate family member shall be entitled to purchase the firearm on behalf of a qualifying sheriff or deputy sheriff if the sheriff or deputy sheriff was unable to do so prior to his death. The provisions of this Section shall not apply if the family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under the provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law. If more than one immediate family member seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest immediate family member who seeks to purchase the firearm shall be entitled to purchase the firearm on behalf of the qualifying sheriff or deputy sheriff.

§2235. Retirement; purchase of firearm

Any municipal police officer who retires with at least twenty years of active service and who is in good standing with the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System shall be entitled to purchase his firearm at

1 fair market value upon retirement, subject to approval by the chief of police.  
2 In accordance with the provisions of this Section, an immediate family  
3 member shall be entitled to purchase the firearm on behalf of a qualifying  
4 municipal police officer if the officer was unable to do so prior to his death.  
5 The provisions of this Section shall not apply if the family member is  
6 prohibited from possessing a firearm under the provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or  
7 any other state or federal law. If more than one immediate family member  
8 seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest immediate family member who  
9 seeks to purchase the firearm shall be entitled to purchase the firearm on  
10 behalf of the qualifying municipal police officer."

12 On page 2, line 2, after "firearm of" and before "killed" delete "member of state police" and  
13 insert "law enforcement officer"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 8

15 On page 2, line 3, after "a" delete the remainder of the line and insert "law enforcement  
16 officer as defined by R.S. 40:1665.2(B)(1),(2), and (3)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 9

18 On page 2, at the beginning of line 4, delete "state police"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 10

20 On page 2, delete line 7 in its entirety and insert the following:

21 "head of the law enforcement agency. The provisions of this Section shall  
22 not apply if the family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under  
23 the provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law. If more than  
24 one immediate family member seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest  
25 immediate family member who seeks to purchase the firearm shall be entitled  
26 to purchase the firearm on behalf of the qualifying law enforcement officer."
