
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Original Senate Bill No. 209
by Senator Walsworth

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 13, after "**D.**" delete the remainder of the line and insert "**The Board of**
3 **Regents, each public postsecondary education management board, and each public**
4 **postsecondary institution, as appropriate, shall:**"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 2, line 14, between "**(1)**" and "**academic**" change "**Establish**" to "**Approve**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, line 27, after "**textbooks**" delete the remainder of the line and insert "**, course**
9 **materials, any costs associated with applying course credit to a public postsecondary**
10 **institution transcript, and any costs associated with instructor training.**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 3, line 2, after "**supervision**" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 3 through
13 11, and insert "**servicing as a course provider pursuant to R.S. 17:4002.4 to annually**
14 **provide to the state Department of Education a list of dual enrollment courses offered,**
15 **including any prerequisites, the course delivery method, and, if applicable, the location**
16 **where the course will be offered.**"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 3, line 15, between "**college**" and "**and**" change "**courseware**" to "**coursework**"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 3, at the end of line 20, insert "**However, a local education agency shall not pay**
21 **any costs that are provided to, or on behalf of, a student who has been awarded any**
22 **federal or state scholarship or grant that fully or partially funds the cost of**
23 **participating in dual enrollment courses.**"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 7

25 On page 4, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

26 "**(h) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall assist the**
27 **Board of Regents in reporting the information required by this Paragraph.**"
