13	(1)(a) For ad valorem taxes due in 2017 and thereafter, the exemption shall
14	apply beginning in the tax year in which any of the following persons died or 2017,
15	whichever is later:
16	(i) A member of the armed forces of the United States or the Louisiana
17	National Guard who died while on active duty, or while performing their duties as
18	a .
19	(ii) A state police officer, or a who died while on duty.
20	(iii) A law enforcement or fire protection officer who qualified for the salary
21	supplement authorized in Section 10(D)(3) of this Article is entitled to an exemption
22	from ad valorem tax for the total assessed value of their homestead. The exemption
23	shall apply beginning in the tax year in which the person died or 2017, whichever is
24	later, and shall be applicable only if all of the following conditions are met: who died
