
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2017 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 99 by Representative Carpenter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "matters;" and before "and" insert "to provide for the use of increased
3 fees; to provide for the creation of an equipment fund; to provide for a contingent effective
4 date;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 13, after "(13)" and before "For" insert "(a)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

9 "(b) Forty percent of the funds authorized by this Paragraph shall be used to
10 assist in funding the purchase or updating of necessary equipment to carry out the
11 efficient performance of all duties imposed by law on constables or marshals. The
12 funds provided in this Subparagraph shall be deposited into an equipment fund which
13 shall be subject to and included in the constables or marshals' annual audit. A copy
14 of the audit shall be filed with the legislative auditor who shall make it available to
15 the public."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 1, line 16, after "(14)" and before "For" insert "(a)"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

19 On page 1, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

20 "(b) Forty percent of the funds authorized by this Paragraph shall be used to
21 assist in funding the purchase or updating of necessary equipment to carry out the
22 efficient performance of all duties imposed by law on constables and marshals. The
23 funds provided in this Subparagraph shall be deposited into an equipment fund which
24 shall be subject to and included in the constables or marshals' annual audit. A copy
25 of the audit shall be filed with the legislative auditor who shall make it available to
26 the public."

27 AMENDMENT NO. 6

28 On page 1, after line 19, add the following:

29 "Section 2. In accordance with the provisions of R.S. 13:62, the increase in
30 court costs or fees as provided for in this Act shall become effective if and when the
31 Judicial Council provides a recommendation that such court costs or fees meet the
32 applicable guidelines in its 2018 Report to the Louisiana Legislature."
