Abstract: Provides that funding to a parish council on aging not exceed \$100,000 unless funding is appropriated by the legislature for that purpose.

Present law provides for the annual distribution of funds by the office of elderly affairs to the parish councils on aging. The greater of \$37,500 or \$2.50 per parish resident 60 years or older shall be distributed to each parish. No parish may receive more than \$100,000.

Proposed law retains the \$100,000 limit in present law unless additional funding is appropriated by the legislature for that purpose.

Effective July 1, 2017.

(Amends R.S. 46:1606(A) and (B)(1))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to the original bill:

1. Add a provision that allows the \$100,000 limit on funding to parish councils on aging to be removed if additional funds are appropriated for that purpose.
