13 corporation, effective no later than the time that the applying corporation will begin
14 to use the registrant's former name."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 2, line 12, change "(3)" to "(2)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 6

18 On page 3, between lines 12 and 13 insert

19 (1) The other corporation is about to change its name, or to cease doing business, or
20 is being liquidated, or, if a foreign corporation, is about to withdraw from doing
21 business in this state; and the written consent of the other corporation to the adoption
22 of its name, or a nondistinguishable name, has been given and is filed with the
23 articles. The other registrant consents to the use of the name in writing and submits
24 the document required by law to change its name to one that is distinguishable from
25 the name of the applying corporation, effective no later than the time that the
26 applying corporation will begin to use the registrant's former name."

27 AMENDMENT NO. 7

28 On page 5, between lines 3 and 4 insert

29 "(a) The corporation or other limited liability company is about to change its name,
30 to cease doing business, or is being liquidated, or, if a foreign corporation or limited
31 liability company, is about to withdraw from doing business in this state, and the
32 written consent of the corporation or other limited liability company to the adoption
33 of its name or a nondistinguishable name has been given and is filed with the articles
34 of organization. The other registrant consents to the use of the name in writing and
35 submits the document required by law to change its name to one that is
36 distinguishable from the name of the applying corporation or limited liability
37 company, effective no later than the time that the applying corporation or limited
38 liability company will begin to use the registrant's former name."
