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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 4 through 6 and insert "each public postsecondary institution to  
3 address the prevention of unplanned pregnancies among unmarried college students as part  
4 of freshman orientation; to provide for related discretionary actions and activities; and to"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, at the beginning of line 13, change "L." to "L.(1)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, at the end of line 16 and the beginning of line 17, delete "**to develop and**  
9 **implement an action plan**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, line 1, between "**students**" and the period "." insert "**as part of an institution's**  
12 **freshman orientation activities**"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 2 through 29 and on page 3, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert the  
15 following:

16 **"(2)(a) As part of freshman orientation, each institution shall, as deemed**  
17 **appropriate, provide information to students that is recognized as medically**  
18 **accurate by the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists**  
19 **regarding the prevention of unplanned pregnancy including, without limitation,**  
20 **abstinence education.**

21 **(b) In no instance shall any information be disseminated regarding**  
22 **abortion methods, techniques, or providers, nor shall any student be directed**  
23 **to information or services provided by Planned Parenthood or any abortion**  
24 **provider.**

25 **(3) At its discretion, a public postsecondary institution may also:**

26 **(a) Identify opportunities to raise awareness of and provide information**  
27 **for the prevention of unplanned pregnancies across the entire student**  
28 **population.**

29 **(b) Identify opportunities for postsecondary students to serve as mentors**  
30 **or role models of successful behaviors and healthy choices for high school**  
31 **students.**

32 **(c) Identify public and private grants available to address the prevention**  
33 **of unplanned pregnancy and to promote student success, including any**  
34 **partnerships necessary to successfully compete for grants.**

35 **(d) Collaborate with community healthcare providers and federally**  
36 **qualified health centers to promote access to care.**

37 **(e) Identify challenges faced by students who are single parents,**  
38 **including child care, transportation, and financial aid, and identify possible**  
39 **methods to assist such students to successfully complete college.**

40 **(f) Identify other topics or issues related to the prevention and reduction**  
41 **of unplanned pregnancies among postsecondary students."**
