Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to Reengrossed House Bill No. 455 by Representative Abramson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 27, after "jurisdiction" delete "." and insert "."

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 9, line 8, after "C." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 9 through 23
5 and insert the following:

6 "Whenever there is a question regarding whether an offender, convicted or
7 adjudicated in a Louisiana state court of an offense requiring registration and
8 notification pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter, as a fifteen-year, a
9 twenty-five-year, or a lifetime registrant, the Sexual Predator Apprehension Team
10 of the Department of Justice shall have the authority to make determinations
11 regarding the appropriate time period of registration in accordance with the
12 provisions of this Chapter. When such a determination is made by the Sexual
13 Predator Apprehension Team of the Department of Justice, the determination shall
14 be noted in the offender's profile on the State Sex Offender and Child Predator
15 Registry. These determinations shall be binding for purposes of enforcement of the
16 registration and notification provisions of this Chapter unless overturned by a court
17 of competent jurisdiction pursuant to R.S. 15:544.1 when a petition is filed within
18 one hundred eighty days of the date of the written notice. Failure to timely file a
19 petition for such relief pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection shall constitute
20 a waiver by the offender and shall make the registration and notification period
21 determination by the Department of Justice binding and final."
