VETERANS EGF DECREASE LF RV See Note
Provides free parking for disabled veterans at airports

Proposed law requires free parking for a disabled veteran, his vehicle, and his passengers at any public airport for up to 10 days. After 10 days, proposed law specifies a disabled veteran may be charged the customary parking fee for each day that exceeds the 10 days. Proposed law requires the disabled veteran provide proof of disability in the form of a military honor license plate or a disabled veteran identification card issued by US Department of Veterans Affairs. Proposed law provides that each airport may determine its own procedures for validating parking vouchers or reimbursing parking fees.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law is anticipated to decrease revenues of local governmental entities by an indeterminable amount. The proposed legislation requires public airports to allow disabled veterans to park up to 10 days for free. There are seven public airports in LA that provide commercial air service to passengers. All of the public airports are owned and operated by local governmental entities. To the extent that parking fees are utilized as revenue in the operation of the airport, this measure may decrease revenues to the seven local governmental entities. Information provided by the Department of Public Safety, Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV) indicates there are 27,848 disabled veteran licensed plates currently issued.
