HIGHWAYS: Designates a portion of Highway 171 in Anacoco, La., as the "Sergeant James Edward Martin Memorial Highway"

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Requires the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain signage provided local or private money is received to pay for the cost and installation of the signage, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Redesignates a portion of U.S. 171 in Anacoco as the "Sergeant James Edward Martin Memorial Highway".

Provides that in the event of a conflict with <u>present law</u> (Acts 2003 R.S., No. 75), this designation shall supercede.

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway redesignation, provided local or private monies are received by the department to fabricate and install the signs equal to the department's actual costs, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Effective Aug. 1, 2017.
