HIGHWAYS: Authorizes the Regional Transit Authority to solicit and enter into public-private partnership contracts

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) to solicit proposals for and enter into contracts for public-private partnership projects for a transportation facility, as defined in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 48:2073), provided the authority complies with <u>present law</u> applicable to public-private partnership projects of the La. Transportation Authority when the commissioners of the RTA determine a public-private partnership is in the best interest of taxpayers and receives approval from the House and Senate transportation, highways, and public works committees.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires <u>present law</u> provisions that require a payment bond and the process to file claims against a contractor are applicable in the same manner as any other Dept. of Transportation and Development project.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the RTA from receiving an unsolicited proposal for a public-private partnership project.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
