ACT 109 (SB 77) 2017 Regular Session Lambert

<u>Prior law</u> prohibited the taking of shad and skipjack during the closed season and on weekends of the open season.

<u>New law</u> allows the taking of shad during the closed season and on weekends of the open season with a shad gill net for bait purposes only and with the following limitations:

- (1) The shad gill net shall not exceed 150 feet in length.
- (2) No more than 50 pounds of shad shall be taken per day.
- (3) The gill net shall be attended at all times.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 12, 2017).
