Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Concurrent Resolution No. 89 by Representative Stokes

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, between "Orleans" and "and" insert "and the Board of Regents and the
3 Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College to
4 study jointly the possibility of revising the classification and admission standards of
5 Southern University at New Orleans"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 2, at the end of line 23, change the period "." to a semicolon ";" and add "and"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

10 "WHEREAS, according to the Master Plan for Public Postsecondary
11 Education in Louisiana: 2011, Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO),
12 as the only public, historically black university in New Orleans, is primarily
13 a teaching institution whose mission is successful education of undergraduate
14 students and services to the employers and communities in its region; and
15 WHEREAS, under the Board of Regents classification system and
16 associated admission standards, many are concerned about whether SUNO
17 is able to properly fulfill this mission in its region and believe that
18 reclassification or modification of the admission standards is needed in order
19 for SUNO to successfully fulfill its mission."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 4

21 On page 2, line 27, between "Orleans" and "and to" insert "and the Board of Regents and the
22 Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College to
23 study jointly the possibility of revising the classification and admission standards of
24 Southern University at New Orleans"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 5

26 On page 3, line 4, after "System," delete the remainder of the line and insert "the president
27 of the University of New Orleans, the chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Southern
28 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, the president of the Southern
29 University System, and the president of Southern University at New Orleans."
