CIVIL PROCEDURE EG1 NO IMPACT See Note Provides right of oral argument in contradictory proceedings. (gov sig)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the right to present oral argument, in addition to written briefs, at all contradictory hearings in civil cases. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that final judgments obtained without allowing oral argument as provided for in proposed law shall be mandatory grounds for seeking a new hearing. <u>Proposed law</u> allows courts reasonable control over oral arguments. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that motion to annul a judgment as provided in <u>present law</u> must be brought within 30 days after the service, notice, or mailing of judgment as required by <u>present law</u>.
