16 "§753. Louisiana State Board of Dentistry; appointment of members; term of office;
17 vacancies; nominating meetings; quorum; domicile

19 B. The board shall be composed of such seventeen members to include three
20 consumers, thirteen qualified and licensed dentists as provided in Subsection C of
21 this Section and one qualified and licensed dental hygienist.

22 C. Each member of the board shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

23 * * *

24 (4)(a) Three consumer members shall be selected from the state at-large and
25 appointed by the governor. The consumer members of the board shall include one
26 licensed attorney, one certified public accountant, and one member representing
27 AARP. In addition, all consumer members shall possess all of the following
28 qualifications:

29 (i) Is a citizen of the United States and has been a resident of Louisiana for
30 at least one year immediately prior to appointment.

31 (ii) Has attained the age of majority.

32 (iii) Shall not have ever been a licensed dentist, nor shall he have a spouse
33 who has ever been a licensed dentist.

34 (iv) Has never been convicted of a felony.

35 (v) Shall not have nor shall ever have had a material financial interest in the
36 practice of dentistry.

37 (b) The consumer members shall be full voting members of the board with
38 all rights and privileges conferred on board members, except that the consumer
39 members shall not participate in the grading of individual examinations.

40 (5) In the event the governor declares a state of emergency, all nominating
41 procedures may be delayed for a period of not longer than one hundred eighty days
42 from the date the emergency was first declared by the governor.
