**SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Senator Barrow to Engrossed House Bill No. 468 by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, lines 4 and 5, change "to define unregulated services and establish natural hair  
3 braiding as an unregulated service;" to "to require the board to establish a curriculum for  
4 both natural and synthetic hair;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 2, delete lines 28 and 29

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 3, delete lines 1 and 2

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 3, delete lines 4 through 18 and insert the following:

11 "§581.1. Natural and synthetic hair braiding

12 A. The board shall promulgate rules and regulations establishing a  
13 curriculum for alternative hair design that includes both natural and synthetic  
14 hair.

15 B. The curriculum shall include at least five hundred hours of  
16 instruction that includes, but is not limited to, classes in bacteriology and  
17 sanitation, client consultation, hair types and hair structure, scalp diseases  
18 and disorders, shampoos, conditioners, herbal treatments and rinses, braiding  
19 and sculpting, and the Louisiana Cosmetology Act and rules and regulations.

20 C. Nothing shall prevent or prohibit a local governing authority from  
21 levying an occupational tax on natural hair braiding services."

22 AMENDMENT NO. 5

23 Delete Committee Amendment No. 5 proposed by the Senate Committee on Commerce,  
24 Consumer Protection and International Affairs and adopted by the Senate on May 31, 2017.
