

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**HB 625****2017 Regular Session****Henry**

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Increase (decrease) appropriations as follows: Interagency Transfers by \$7,072,417; Self-generated Revenues by \$42,469,487; Statutory Dedications by \$39,415,775; and Federal Funds by (\$399,721,127).
2. Deem appropriations out of the State Emergency Response Fund and the Overcollections Fund bona fide obligations through June 30, 2018.
3. Deem certain prior appropriations in Sales Tax Dedications and State Aid to Local Government Entities as bona fide obligations through December 31, 2017 or June 30, 2018.
4. Make supplemental changes to Capital Outlay Act increasing Interagency Transfers by \$740,000 and Fees and Self-generated Revenues by \$13,250,000 and spending \$5,000,000 of interest earnings.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for FY 2016-2017. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) no change; Interagency Transfers by \$8,432,766; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$63,904,768, Statutory Dedications by \$52,591,579, and Federal Funds by \$3,945,903.

Make supplemental changes to Capital Outlay Act increasing Interagency Transfers by \$740,000 and Fees and Self-generated Revenues by \$13,250,000 and spending \$5,000,000 of interest earnings.
