PUBLIC HEALTH: Requests state-level collaboration on cancer investigation and local public health notifications regarding cancer incidence

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Revise provisions calling for the La. Public Health Institute and the La. Cancer Prevention and Control Programs to lead a collaborative effort regarding cancer investigation to provide instead that the effort be coordinated by the La. Cancer Prevention and Control Programs exclusively.
2. Add the La. Public Health Institute to the listing of stakeholder groups with which the La. Cancer Prevention and Control Programs shall collaborate in the effort called for in the Resolution.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Urges and requests the La. Cancer Prevention and Control Programs of the School of Public Health of the LSU Health Sciences Center-New Orleans to lead a collaborative effort to improve cancer investigation and intervention functions in this state, and to develop recommendations concerning effective and responsible practices for issuing local public health notifications regarding cancer incidence.

Provides that La. Cancer Prevention and Control Programs shall issue a report of such recommendations to the legislative committees on health and welfare no later than 30 days prior to the convening of the 2018 R.S.
