TRANSPORTATION: Urges and requests the Department of Transportation and Development to place a dedicated left turn traffic control signal in the north bound lane on Essen Lane at its intersection with Essen Park Avenue near the LSU Rural Life Museum

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to place a dedicated
3 left turn traffic control signal in the north bound lane on Essen Lane at its
4 intersection with Essen Park Avenue near the LSU Rural Life Museum.

5 WHEREAS, dedicated left turn traffic control signals are designed to enhance
6 highway safety, facilitate orderly movement of traffic, and reduce traffic delays and
7 accidents; and

8 WHEREAS, Essen Lane is a heavily traveled area, with the LSU Rural Life Museum
9 located near the interstate, and a directional traffic control signal may allow those working
10 at or visiting the museum easier and safer access as well as alleviate traffic congestion.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
12 urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development, in consultation with
13 the local governing authority, to erect a dedicated left turn traffic control signal in the north
14 bound lane on Essen Lane at its intersection with Essen Park Avenue near the LSU Rural
15 Life Museum.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the
17 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
