2	To commend Kathryn Camille Denson, administrative secretary to Senate President John A.
3	Alario Jr., for her distinguished career and exemplary public service to the state of
4	Louisiana and to congratulate her upon the occasion of her retirement from the
5	Louisiana State Senate.
6	WHEREAS, at this time, the membership of the Senate of the Legislature of
7	Louisiana wishes to commend Camille Denson for twenty-six years of exceptional service
8	to this body; and
9	WHEREAS, with a total of over thirty-one years of state service, Camille embarked
10	on her public service career with employment in the state departments of agriculture and
11	labor; and
12	WHEREAS, in 1991, Camille began her duties with the Senate with assignments as
13	secretary to the Senate Health and Welfare Committee working with chairmen, senators
14	Mike Cross, Gerry Hinton, and Don Hines and later as secretary to the Senate Education
15	Committee working with chairmen, senators Tom Schedler and Ben Nevers; and
16	WHEREAS, Camille served in the office of president of the Senate on two separate
17	occasions, first during the administration of Senate President Donald E. "Don" Hines and
18	lastly under Senate President John A. Alario Jr.; and

1	WHEREAS, during her tenure, Camille has always been loyal and dedicated, willing
2	to go the extra mile and to share her knowledge and expertise with others, and she has
3	conducted herself in the most cordial, concise, and compassionate manner possible and
4	presented a kind demeanor in every situation; and
5	WHEREAS, Camille has always focused on the task at hand; she is a planner who
6	accounts for all the minute details and logistics of a committee meeting or other
7	circumstance that demand her undivided attention; and
8	WHEREAS, while in the office of the senate president, Camille's many tasks
9	included greeting visitors, assisting in meeting schedules, handling correspondence, and
10	coordinating the events for Former Legislators Recognition Day; and
11	WHEREAS, Camille was born to parents Albert and Mignon Elias and attended
12	LaSalle High School, Northwestern State University of Louisiana, and Northeast Louisiana
13	State College; now known as the University of Louisiana-Monroe; and
14	WHEREAS, she was married to John E. Denson, an equestrian and horse trainer, for
15	twenty years and together they reared two sons, Michael Todd and John Bradley, teaching
16	them to ride as soon as they could sit on a saddle; and
17	WHEREAS, in 1988, John died suddenly from cardiac arrest; widowed, Camille
18	became sole provider for her family in an instant; she supported her family and life was
19	difficult at times, but she succeeded and provided for everyone; many sacrifices were made,
20	but they all survived and thrived; and
21	WHEREAS, after three decades, July 15, 2017, is the date of her retirement from
22	state government and Camille intends to enjoy each day of retirement to its fullest; and
23	WHEREAS, "Dolce far Niente" is an Italian expression which translates as "the
24	sweetness of doing nothing", although Camille shall fill her leisure time with the pursuit of
25	varied interests that include visits with her grandson, Lucas; and her granddaughters,
26	Madison and McKenzie; travel to far-off places and trips to the beach, and reading works
27	of fiction, there shall also be "lazy" days that are delightfully quiet and serene; and
28	WHEREAS, in the days to follow, Camille shall fondly recall the memories of
29	longtime friendships, past legislative sessions, numerous sine dies, the rarefied environment

of state government, and the colorful cast of characters that have populated the state
