APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 (Item #1)

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make certain reductions in appropriations from certain sources
3 to be allocated to designated agencies and purposes in specific amounts for the
4 making of supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017; to provide for an
5 effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for FY 2016-2017. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) no change; Interagency Transfers by \$8,432,766; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$64,184,768, Statutory Dedications by \$54,356,502, and Federal Funds by \$3,945,903. Also nullifies \$17,000,000 in State General Fund (Direct) appropriations contained in Act 17 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature from money paid in protest and held in escrow.

Make supplemental changes to Capital Outlay Act increasing Interagency Transfers by \$1,940,000 and Fees and Self-generated Revenues by \$13,250,000 and spending \$5,000,000 of interest earnings.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to the original bill:

1. Increase (decrease) appropriations as follows: Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$280,000 and Statutory Dedications by \$1,764,923.
