

## **RÉSUMÉ DIGEST**

**ACT 205 (HB 219)**

**2017 Regular Session**

**Leopold**

Prior law provided that a bail undertaking ceases and a surety is relieved of all obligations upon conviction and imposition of a sentence or the pronouncement of a sentence or condition of probation of a defendant in misdemeanor cases.

Prior law further provided that the bail undertaking ceases and the surety is relieved of all obligations upon conviction in felony cases.

New law provides that a surety's bail obligation is relieved upon conviction in any case.

Effective August 1, 2017.
