## **RÉSUMÉ DIGEST**

## ACT 2 (HB 7) 2017 First Extraordinary Session

<u>Existing law</u> creates the Seabrook Neighborhood Improvement and Security District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision for the primary object and purpose of promoting and encouraging the beautification, security, and overall betterment of the district. Provides for the district's boundaries, governance, and powers and duties.

Existing law authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans, subject to voter approval, to impose a parcel fee on behalf of the district not to exceed \$200 per year for each parcel. Prior law provided that the fee expired on Dec. 31, 2018. New law instead provides that the fee expires at the end of the term provided for in the proposition authorizing the fee, not to exceed eight years. Existing law provides for renewal of the fee.

Effective upon signature of governor (March 3, 2017).
